Disabled Facilities Grants (DFG) Self-funders



The Disabled Facilities Grant (DFG) is only available for "disabled people with eligible needs, assessed by an occupational therapist, and who are financially eligible through passporting benefits or following a means test."

The following information relates to situations where:

• Your **assessed contribution is higher than the cost of the works** i.e. you are not financially eligible for a grant and will be funding the works yourself.

In such circumstances it will be your responsibility to:

- organise and pay for any architect drawings or structural calculations to determine your plan of works
- to draw up a schedule of work (if not provided by architect)
- to obtain at least two (ideally three) quotes for your schedule.

The Council can provide you upon request, a contractors list/company or suppliers details that you may find helpful when planning and costing your choice of works.

If, at the time of request, capacity allows and you have no alternative means of obtaining plans and quotes yourself, The Council may be able to facilitate you with this. However, where this service is offered, an administration fee will be payable (for full details please view our policy – eastleigh.gov.uk/DFG)
