Domestic refuse – 140L wheeled bin or 180L wheeled bin (black body, black lid) for flats, 1100L wheeled bin (grey body, black lid) – fortnightly collection

Domestic recycling – 180L wheeled bin or 240L wheeled bin (green bin, green lid) for flats 1100L wheeled bin (green body, green lid) – fortnightly collection

Domestic glass – 40L glass box (black) for flats 240L wheeled bin (green body, green lid with hole for bottles) – fortnightly collection

Domestic food waste – 40L grab box (brown body, brown lid), for flats 240L brown bin, brown lid) – weekly collection

We use two sites to dispose of waste and recycling. Veolia Netley Transfer Station, Portsmouth Road, Southampton, SO19 9NA (dry mixed recycling and refuse) and Veolia Otterbourne, Poles Lane, Otterbourne, Winchester SO21 2EA (dry mixed recycling, refuse, glass, food and bulky).
