## Adoption Statement – Revised Statement of Community Involvement (SCI)

The Revised Statement of Community Involvement was adopted by Eastleigh Borough Council on 23 May 2024. The document sets out how Eastleigh Borough Council intends to involve the community, businesses, organisations and statutory agencies in decision on planning matters including the Local Plan and planning applications. It is a revision to the Statement of Community Involvement adopted in December 2023.

The Statement of Community Involvement was initially published for consultation between 26 June – 6 September 2023. Following the consultation, the Council made modifications to take account of representations, update and improve the document. Detailed comments received and the Council's response to them are published in the consultation statement available on the Council's website. The revised document includes one further minor change to the text and corrects errors in the consultation statement.
