

**THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH
(EASTLEIGH TOWN CENTRE) (AMENDMENT NO. 08)
ORDER 2018**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Eastleigh Borough Council pursuant to arrangements with Hampshire County Council has made the above mentioned Traffic Regulation Orders in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2, 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The general effect of this Order is to insert into The Borough of Eastleigh (Eastleigh Town Centre) Consolidation Order 2013, The Borough of Eastleigh (Arnold Road Area) (Residents Parking Places and Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (Fourth Zone) (Controlled Zone) Order 2004 and The Borough of Eastleigh (Goldsmiths Road and O'Connell Road Area) (Residents Parking Places and Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (Eighth Zone) (Controlled Zone) Order 2006 new waiting restrictions and amend some existing restrictions as detailed below:

**a) 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions
in the following roads:**

Launceston Drive	Parham Drive
Sopwith Road	Tower Lane
Judd Close	Oak Tree Way
Oxburgh Close	York Road

b) Legalised Disabled Bays

222a High Street	Greenwood Close
331 High Street	38 Woodpecker Way
32 Cranbury Road	16 Grantham Road

Any persons wishing to question the validity of this Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from 18 January 2019 apply to the High Court for this purpose
