Re: The Eastleigh Borough Council (Bridleway No 724 and Footpath No 782 Bishopstoke) Diversion Order 2017

I, Ian Austin, Head of Legal Services of Eastleigh Borough Council ("the Council"), confirm that the highway required by Article 2 of the Eastleigh Borough Council (Bridleway No 724 and Footpath No 782 Bishopstoke) Diversion Order 2017 ("the Order"), namely a 3 metre wide bridleway as shown in thick black dashes on the plan attached to the Order ("the Plan") running south westwards commencing from point H and then running for a distance of 31 metres to point G and then running for a distance of 178 metres to point F and running for a distance of 51 metres to point E widening gradually from 3 metres to 5 metres midway along this section and then narrowing gradually back to 3 metres and then running for a distance of 130 metres to point C, is to the reasonable satisfaction of the Council.
