If you are not the only person in the footage, we will only release the CCTV footage to you directly if we don't have any privacy concerns. These concerns will be because one or more of the following apply:

- The length of the footage is too long, meaning that the amount of personal information captured is too great. Generally, requests for footage should be limited to half an hour.
- The risk of prejudice to those individuals if re-identification occurs is high
- The individuals in the footage have a higher expectation of privacy due to the location of the camera
- The incident captured is of a sensitive nature (e.g. a criminal offence or road traffic incident)
- Eastleigh Borough Council can refuse your request if sharing the footage will put a criminal investigation at risk.
